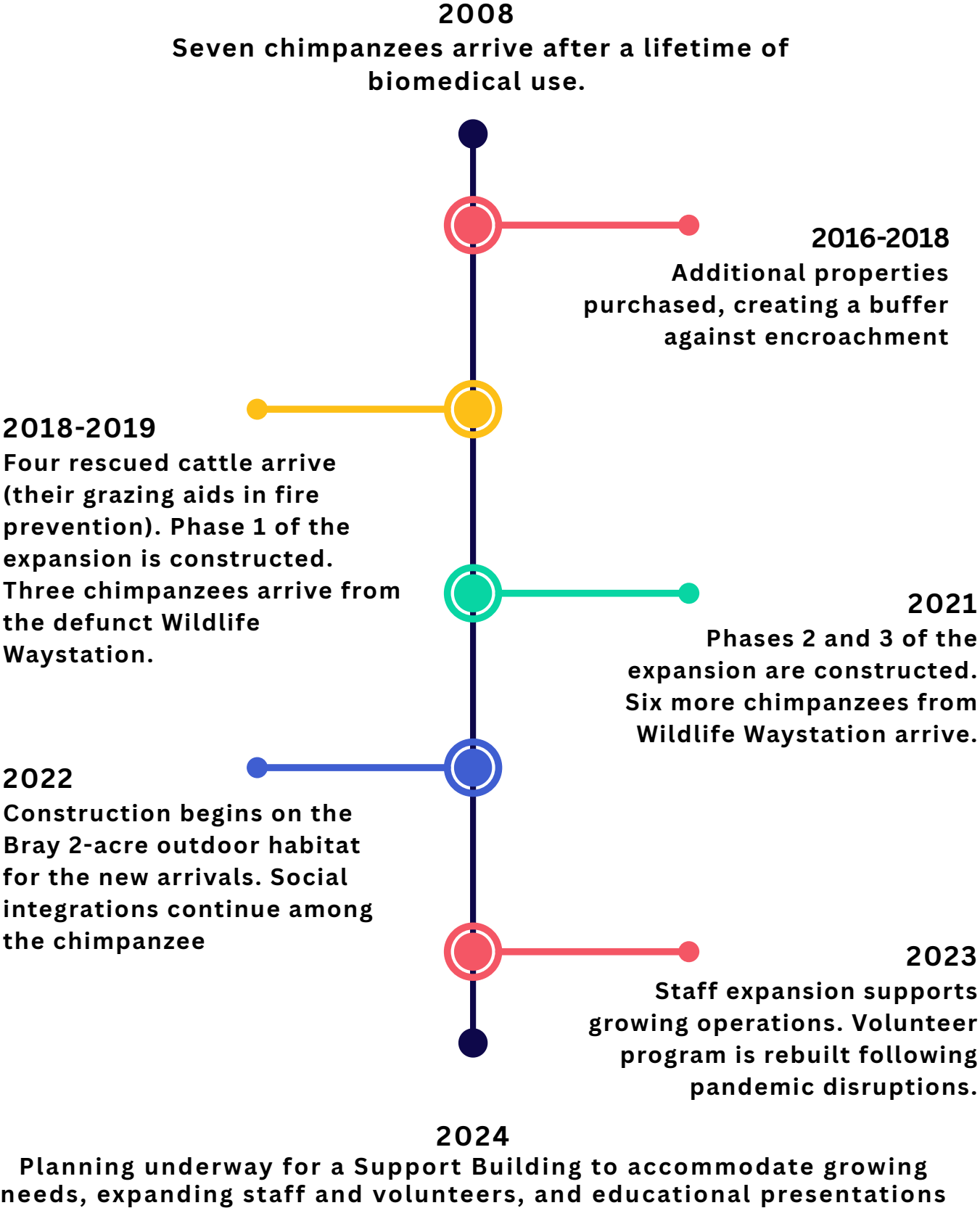

# REFLECTING

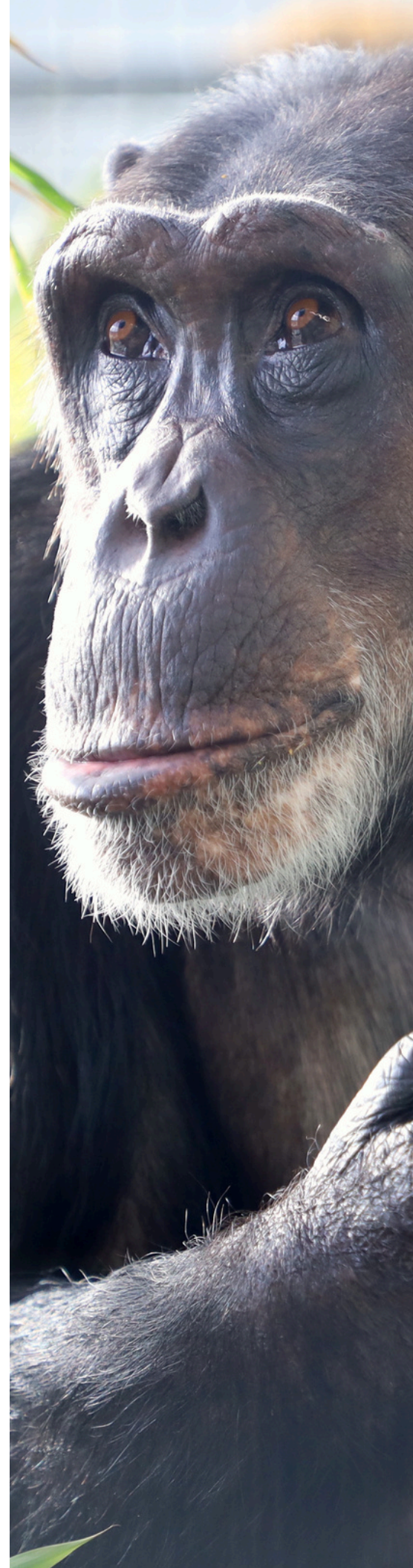

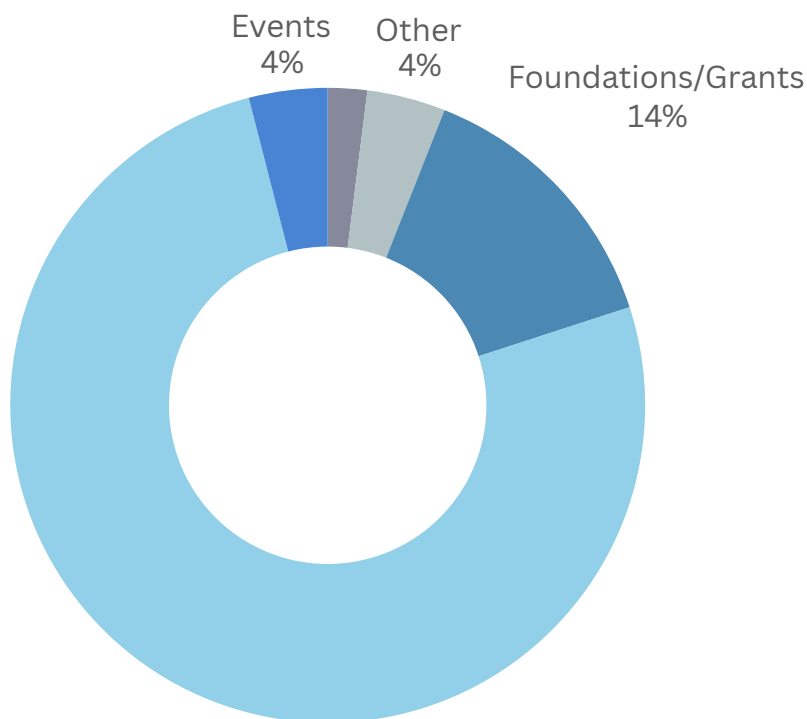

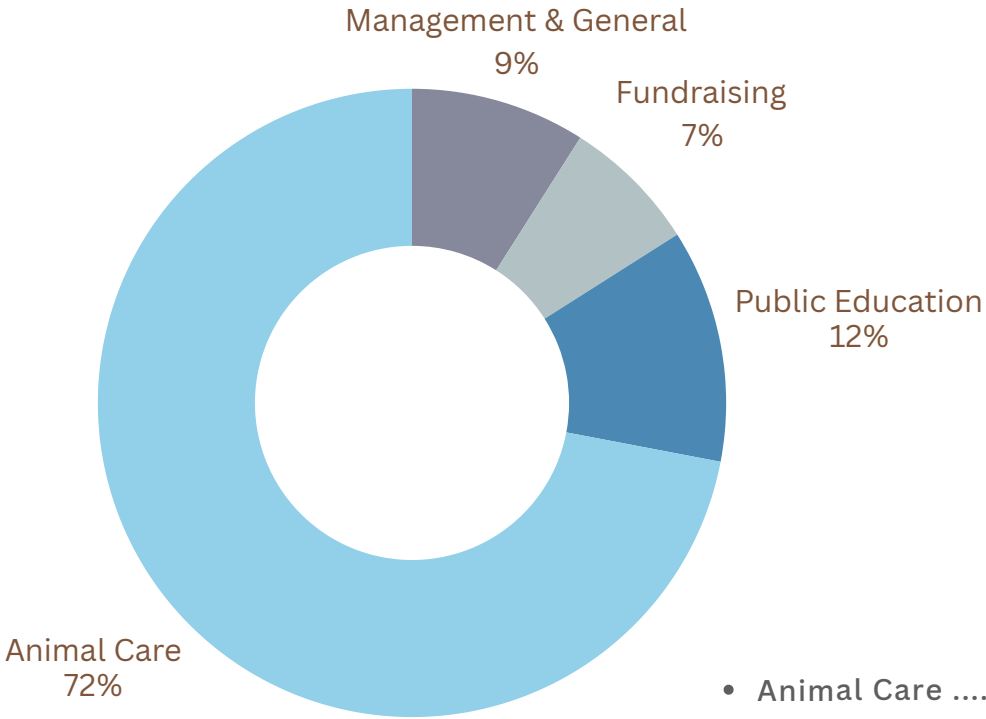
